<b>Married, Filing Jointly or a Qualifying widow(er)</b>	<b>\$27,700</b>	<b>\$29,200</b>	<b>\$30,700</b>
<b>Head of Household</b>	<b>\$20,800</b>	<b>\$22,650</b>	

The IRS only allows itemized deductions to the extent that they EXCEED the standard deduction. If your medical expenses, taxes, interest paid, charitable contributions, etc. do not exceed the standard deduction this information will not be needed to prepare your return.
